

Lifetime Skills

Written in an RTI Model Format

Implementation: Twice monthly teachers of 7th and 8th grade students will be asked to rate students in the areas of Responsibility, Social Interaction, and Study Skills. The ratings will be collected by the school counselor and monthly averages computed with the following outcomes:

Benchmark (Tier I) Students obtaining monthly averages above 3.0.

- 1) If average is above 4.5, a posting is made on School Master and positive letter sent home.
- 2) Student invited to monthly reward assembly

Strategic (Tier 2) Students obtaining monthly averages between 2.0 and 2.9

- 1) Meet with School Counselor to discuss ratings, classes, and develop a plan for improvement
- 2) Student not invited to monthly reward assembly

Intensive (Tier 3) Students obtaining ratings below 2.0

- 1) Posting made on School Master
- 2) Letter sent home expressing concerns about student and offering a school conference with parents.
- 3) Meet with School Counselor to discuss ratings, classes, and develop a plan for improvement.
- 4) Student not invited to monthly reward assembly

Student may lose their opportunity for the monthly Reward Assembly for other reasons, such as those listed below:

- 1) Three documented incidences of noncompliant behavior. (Hats, cell phones, sitting on heater, etc.)
- 2) Major incident resulting in action from office.
- 3) Principal may remove a student from the assembly if student is in the process of an investigation, or other factors.
