Request from Susan Ruby: Tania May asked the AIMS group to begin merging the 2014 SLD guide and 2006 OSPI Using RTI in SLD guides into a document for teams. We are also trying to include resources to prepare districts for 2028. Stephanie King is leading this work. There is a "writing team" and a group of special ed admins who are meeting to begin the process. We would like to have a strong school psych team, geographically representative of areas in the state, to review a draft document. We would like to stay 10 or less in this group, and there are already some areas of the state with school psych representatives. We are seeking a team to review the document and need a psych from the Tri Cities, SW Washington, and NW Washington. This will not be advertised in the PWN at the request of the organizers.

Request for board members to submit a picture and brief profile for our website.

The NASP Convention Committee includes two practitioners and two practitioners (in addition to two SPSY students) from the local convention city to participate in the planning and conduction of the convention as a way to make direct connections to the city itself. This participation starts a year out so that the local team can be mentored by the previous year's team to prepare them for the convention actually slated for their city; thus, they are seeking Seattle local team members who will be invited to participate with the 2024 NOLA team. I have asked Kristi for a list of members whose residence is in the Seattle area and will be emailing folks regarding this opportunity. NASP has already reached out to the SPSY graduate programs in the Seattle area seeking two students to participate on the local team.
